June 12, 2022
Elegant Trapunto Hearts and Butterflies with Micro-Stippling



You will need:

- One 20" x 18" Ivory Solid (In Kit)
- One 20" x 18" Cotton Batting (In Kit)
- One (or two) 11"x 11" High Loft Batting (In Kit)
- One 20" x 20" No Show Stabilizer
- Equisite Thread one shade darker or matching your fabric.

Hooping order:

- No Show Stabilizer on Bottom
- Cotton Batting
- High Loft Batting centered in hoop floating
- Ivory solid Fabric on Top

Raise your embroidery foot height one number.

1. IQ designer
2. Shapes
3. Hoops
4. 10 5/8" x 10 5/8" Hoop AMD= 9 1/2" x 9 1/2"
5. OK
6. Third row down, second from left Heart in each corner
7. OK
8. Settings
9. Grid
10. 1" Grid
11. OK
12. Select
13. Select Box
14. Click and drag a box around each section and move it so the point touches the farthest grid line in each corner.
15. Line Properties To draw a line to close up the butterfly so it will be puffy.
16. Curved Line If you are bad at drawing curved lines, try the straight line.

17. Black
18. OK
19. Draw two lines on each butterfly to close it up.
20. Memory
21. Save on the Machine
22. Shapes We're going to add the heart in the middle
23. Heart
24. Ok
25. Size 5.00" x 5.44"
26. OK
27. Copy
28. Size to 3.90" x 4.25"
29. Center
30. OK
31. Line Properties Now to add stitches!!
32. Bean Stitch (Triple Stitch)
33. Deep Pink
34. Line Bucket
35. Touch the smallest Heart
36. Line Properties
37. Candlewicking
38. Red
39. OK
40. Line Bucket
41. Click on the larger heart
42. Line Properties
43. Candlewicking
44. Purple
45. OK
46. Line Bucket
47. Click on each one of the four swirls around the butterflies to turn them purple.
48. Line Properties
49. Satin Stitch
50. Blue
51. OK
52. Click on all the butterfly parts to turn them blue
53. Fill Properties
54. Stippling Stitch
55. Orange
56. OK
57. Fill Bucket
58. Touch the background to fill it with stippling
59. Fill Properties

60. Circle Button
61. Select
62. 004 Roses
63. OK
64. Green
65. Ok
66. Touch inside the smaller heart to fill it with roses
67. Memory
68. Save on the machine
69. Next This is where you can make changes
70. The stippling should be in the window.
71. Run Pitch from .080" down to .052"
72. Spacing down as small as it will go to 0.080"
73. Distance down to 0.000" so there is no gap.
74. Select until you see the roses in the window
75. Size down to 75%
76. Select so you see purple candlewicking in the window.
77. Do Not LINK
78. Size down to 0.132"
79. Spacing keep at 0.040"
- 80.
81. Select until another purple candlewicking is in the window. Make sure the size is 0.132" and the spacing is 0.040"
82. Keep selecting until you are sure all the purple candlewicking is the same.
83. Select so the blue Satin Stitch is in the window
84. Link
85. Stitch width keep at 0.080"
86. Density up to 110%
87. Select until the red candlewicking is in the window
88. Size up to 0.180"
89. Spacing down to 0.020"
90. Memory
91. Save on the Machine
92. Embroider!!
