Scholarship for The Arc New York Chapter Employees

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Monday, January 11, 2021

About the Scholarship: Four (4) scholarships are presented annually to full time Chapter employees who wish to further their education with the intention of contributing to the field of intellectual or developmental disabilities. The award, in the amount of \$3,000 per recipient, is paid in installments of \$1,500 for two (2) semesters. The funds must be claimed within a four (4) year period from the time the scholarship was awarded.

About Jonathan Weingold: This scholarship honors the memory of Jonathan Weingold, son of Joseph T. Weingold, The Arc New York's first President and Executive Director. In 1970, a tribute was paid to Jonathan stating that he was "the symbol of all the young people who inspired the establishment of this organization and its services and programs." Following that tribute, an annual scholarship was established in his name.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Nominee must be actively employed full time by a Chapter of The Arc New York.
- Employees/students currently receiving a scholarship through The Arc New York are not eligible to receive simultaneous scholarships
- Student must be enrolled in a minimum of 3 credits hours per semester
- Student must be a New York State resident

Application Requirements:

- Completed application
- A letter of recommendation from local Chapter Executive Director or supervising Program Director
- Verification of employment from Chapter Human Resources Department
