- Shacharit with Siyum (after each minyan): 6:45am & 7:40am
- Mincha/Maariv: 6:55pm
- Bedikat Chametz after 7:50pm

Erev Shabbat, Friday, March 26

- Shacharit: 7:00am, 7:40am
- Burn Chametz prior to 11:45am.
- Candle Lighting: 6:52pm
- Mincha/Maariv: 6:55pm

Shabbat, March 27: Erev Pesach

- Shacharit: 7:30am, 7:45am
- Latest time for eating Chametz: 10:31am
- Do Bittul Chametz prior to 11:45am
- Mincha/Maariv: 6:55pm
- Yom Tov Candle Lighting with Shehechyanu (not before): 7:53pm (Refrain from preparing for Yom Tov or the Seder prior to Candle Lighting.)
- Seder should not begin before 7:55pm
- Chatzot: 12:58am

Sunday, March 28: 1st Day of Pesach

- Shacharit: 8:30am, 9:15am
- Mincha/Maariv: 7:00pm
- Yom Tov Candle Lighting with Shehechyanu (not before): 7:54pm
Refrain from preparing for Yom Tov or the Seder prior to Candle Lighting.
- Seder should not begin before: 7:54pm
- Chatzot: 12:58
- Count 1st night of the Omer

Monday, March 29: 2nd Day of Pesach

- Shacharit: 8:30am, 9:15am
- Mincha/Maariv: 7:00pm
- Havdallah: 7:54pm
- Count the 2nd night of the Omer

Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday: Chol Hamoed Pesach

- Shacharit: 6:30am, 7:30am
- Mincha/Maariv: 7:00pm
- Count the Omer

Friday, April 2: Chol Hamoed & Erev Shabbat

- Shacharit: 6:30am, 7:30am
- Candle Lighting without Shehechyanu: 6:57pm
- Mincha/Maariv: 7:00pm
- Count the 6th night of the Omer

Shabbat, April 3: 7th Day of Pesach

- Shacharit: 8:30am, 9:15am
- Mincha/Maariv: 6:50pm
- Yom Tov Candle Lighting without Shehechyanu (not before): 7:58pm
- Count the 7th night of the Omer

Sunday, April 4: 8th Day of Pesach

- Shacharit: 8:30am, 9:15am
- Yizkor approximately 1 hour after minyan begins.
- Mincha/Maariv: 7:05pm
- Havdallah: 7:59pm
- Count the 8th night of the Omer
