SUBJECT: CAPP 79-10 *Cadet Medication Management Best Practices* Now Available

We are engaged in the Year of Ownership in Civil Air Patrol. Focus areas include safety, cadet protection, and stakeholder experience. As part of our efforts to create a safe and nurturing environment for cadets as well as align with best practices, we are excited to share the latest update CAPP 79-10 *Cadet Medication Management Best Practices*. The parent regulation for this guidance is 160-1 (I) *Operation of the CAP Health Service Program*. This pamphlet is being published in advance of upcoming revisions to the CAPR 60-2 and an associated ICL to CAPR 160-1 (I) to ensure appropriate time for planning and coordination.

This pamphlet is testament to the power of collaboration and our core value of respect, as it was a combined effort between Health Services, Safety, Cadet Programs, and Cadet Protection, supported in their efforts by CAP/GC and the command team. This pamphlet allows our cadets to own the act of taking their medications but provides foundational support from senior members to mitigate the risk of medication mismanagement at CAP activities with cadets.
