

Hello Magee Parents/Guardians,

Your child(ren) are quarantined/isolated, so now what?

As we have learned along the way this year, the more information we can communicate the better. Also, please know we are here to help and support. If you have any questions, please reach out to your child's teacher or to Mrs. Sterner.



Distance learning looks very different than last spring. At school, our learners are actively working on the skills they need to be successful if they need to switch to distance learning for a bit. Flexible thinking happens here all the time, learners are really good at it! In addition, we are developing the skills necessary to be resilient self-directed learners and problem solvers. As a parent, sometimes we might feel the need to jump in and help but in doing so we remove the productive struggle our learners really need. IF your child is struggling, please reach out to his/her classroom teacher.

QUARANTINE ATTENDANCE

- **When learners or a classroom are sent home to quarantine, that means they need to stay home, not go in public places, gymnastics, basketball, restaurants, etc.**
They can develop symptoms ANYTIME within the 14 days. If learners develop symptoms, please notify Magee as soon as possible.
- When learners are quarantined and have no symptoms or feel well enough to participate, they are expected to participate in their regular school day virtually. They will be marked present. To participate virtually-
 - *They should access their Google Classroom with their school username and password.*
 - *If Google Classroom is not bookmarked on the device, open a browser window and search for google classroom.*
 - *Then, select the site and log in.*
 - *Your child should then be able to navigate to his/her classroom to find the daily schedule and activities. All of those things will be found under the "class work" tab.*
- If your child is quarantined and is too ill to participate, please CALL (262-968-6450) or EMAIL (doomeb@kmsd.edu) to report your child's illness and symptoms to excuse them from school.
- Learners will be marked absent if they are not participating in class activities during the day without any communication with school.

INSTRUCTION

- The daily schedule is in your child's Google Classroom. Your learner KNOWS how to access the Google Classroom and use the link to access LIVE instruction. (see above)
- Checking in on your learner is great, you ARE NOT expected to sit with your child. His/her classroom teacher will answer questions and/or provide individual attention if needed. Learners also know that they can ask questions or for help and their teacher will hear them. Most learners have seen this in action in their classroom already.
- Reach out to your child's teacher with specific questions or struggles.

SPECIALS

- When individual learners are quarantined, learners participate in specials via choice boards that are accessible through Google Classroom.
- When an entire class is quarantined, specials will be taught live by the specialist teacher at the scheduled class time listed in Google Classroom. Students can access the google meet link on their specials Google Classroom page. Learners are expected to attend and participate.
