


St. Catherine's Strategic Visioning: Pentecost to Pentecost... and beyond!



The total process at a glance...




The Vision Statement

St. Catherine of Alexandria Episcopal Church is dedicated to becoming a vibrant, energized church and faith leader in Temple Terrace and the wider community. St. Catherine's will provide broad worship offerings in the Anglican tradition and a renewed, active campus supported by a stable financial foundation. St. Catherine's has identified four priorities to lead us toward our vision:

- Relevant Christian formation and spiritual development opportunities attractive to a diversity of seekers
- Welcoming and integrating members of all ages and families into an inclusive and multigenerational community
- Cultivating a spirit of gratitude and year-long stewardship, including the growth of our Endowment
- Outreach in service aligned with the needs of the marginalized in a way that demonstrates our Christian faith and forms relationships with love

Underlying Assumptions

- 1) The congregation's agreement (Good Idea) is a dominant value of the variable.
- 2) Willingness to Help is a subordinate value.
- 3) Use Compound Mapping to show both values at the same time (double bar chart)
- 4) Map the first 5 variables (unless there are ties, which could result in another variable or two)

- 6) This plan will come to the Vestry for discussion, minor edits, and approval. If a major change or edit is found to be necessary at this time, engagement with the appropriate Commission(s) or Committee(s) should occur before the edit is approved.
