The Rev. Dr. Andrew McGowan

We are delighted to welcome the Very Rev. Andrew B. McGowan, Dean of Berkeley Divinity School at Yale, as our guest preacher in Holy Week. Dean McGowan will be preaching the liturgies for Maundy Thursday (7pm), Good Friday (12pm), and the Easter Vigil (7pm). An Anglican priest and historian, his work has focused on life of early Christian communities. Before coming to Yale, McGowan was Warden of Trinity College, University of Melbourne, Australia. He is the author or editor of six books, including *Seven Last Words: Cross and Creation* (2021).
