

Holy Saturday April 19: Worship at 8:30am, 3:30pm & 7pm

The Great Vigil & First Eucharist of Easter

The holiest night of the year, when we celebrate the passing of Jesus from death to life. Celebrations begin with the kindling of the Easter fire outside on the front lawn. We process into a darkened church to recount, by candlelight, stories of God's plan for salvation. Then we celebrate the Sacrament of Baptism, the Church is filled with light, bells are rung (bring one!), and we continue with our first, festive celebration of Holy Communion for Easter. Following this service, join us in the Cloister for an Easter Toast – a festive, joyful reception celebrating our Easter Joy!

Easter Sunday April 20: Worship at 7:45am, 9:15am & 11:30am

We look forward to celebrating the joy of Christ's resurrection with you! Please take note of the Easter service times, which are different from a 'normal' Sunday. Easter services are traditionally busy, so please arrive early to be assured of a seat!
