Saturday, May 2 | Volunteer shifts available from 8am - come for a few hours or the whole day!

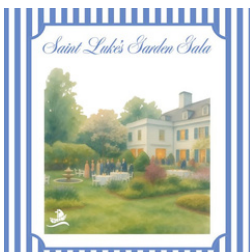

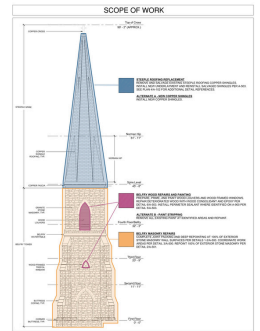
STEEPLE RENOVATION BEGINS!
