

Reid-Hillview Airport Airborne Lead Study – South County Community Meeting
Thursday, August 12, 6 pm

Please join County of Santa Clara staff and Supervisor Mike Wasserman for a virtual community meeting about the results of a study on airborne lead emissions at Reid-Hillview Airport in San José. The meeting on August 12 provides South County community members with an opportunity to learn about the study and ask questions.

The County engaged Dr. Sammy Zahran to study lead emissions at Reid-Hillview Airport. Dr. Zahran is a Professor of Demography in the Dept. of Economics at Colorado State University and a Professor in the Dept. of Epidemiology in the Colorado School of Public Health.

The study analyzed blood lead levels of children within 1.5 miles of Reid-Hillview Airport, piston-engine aircraft activity at the airport, and weather and prevailing winds for the study period to establish whether there is a significant relationship between airplane emissions and blood lead levels. Dr. Zahran and his team reviewed over 300,000 blood lead records provided by the California Department of Public Health, flight records from the Federal Aviation Administration, and weather data available from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.
