FINANCIAL AID GRANT ELIGIBILITY *

- Adults 17 years and older who live within the Morgan Hill Unified School District boundaries
- Demonstrate financial need
- Provide a plan to attend a program or class, or how supplies or tools will be used
- Provide two recommendations from either a teacher or employer
