# Are you behind on rent?

There is help. Emergency rent relief is available.

If you're an income qualified tenant financially impacted by COVID-19 and unable to pay rent, or if you are a landlord who has not received rent because your tenants are financially affected by the pandemic, you may be eligible for emergency rent relief.

## How do I know if I qualify?

Renters whose households are unable to pay rent, financially impacted by COVID-19, and make up to 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI) may be eligible, regardless of immigration status.

## Where can I get help?

If you cannot join us for this event, please visit **SCCRentHelp.org** or call **2-1-1** for specific eligibility criteria, information on how to apply, and to be connected to community partners who are available to help residents fill out applications.

Assistance is available through two separate but complementary programs:

- The statewide CA COVID-19 Rent Relief program, and;
- The Santa Clara County Homelessness Prevention System, which is focused on assisting our community's lowest-income residents.

Note: each program serves residents in different income brackets.
