CAL FIRE MORGAN HILL MURAL COMPLETION

Morgan Hill Art School a nonprofit Art Organization, was approached by Chief Hess of CAL Fire to design and complete a mural on a blank wall facing Monterey Rd.

Anthony Stenberg, Founder of Morgan Hill Art School, met with Chief Hess and several of his staff to plan the design of the mural.

When Morgan Hill Art School agreed to complete the project, Captain Sam Gonzalez from CAL Fire took the lead role in helping Morgan Hill Art School complete the mural.

Morgan Hill Art School became an Exploring Post, and with the help of Susan Vinh, was able to provide a group of youth volunteers to aid with the mural completion.

CAL Fire did not have a budget to fund the project, but Morgan Hill Art School applied for and received grants from Rotary Club Morgan Hill, Farrington Historical Foundation, and Jewish Community Federation for Bill Graham Memorial Foundation to fund the mural.

The mural design concept was given to Dale Dowd, an Art Teacher at Sobrato High School and Morgan Hill Art School, who designed the mural digitally. Anthony and Dale met with Captain Gonzalez and staff to finalize mural design.

Then COVID-19 happened.

During the delay in starting, several troops from Boy Scouts of America reached out to provide more volunteer support
