Calling all artists! The Morgan Hill Library is looking for young artists who would like to have their art displayed in the library. Create your 2D artwork and submit it to the library by March 22nd, 2019. All entries will be displayed in the library April 2019.

Rules:

Age Categories: Participants must be between the ages of 5 and 13.

Media and Technique Requirements:

Any of the following 2D media or techniques may be used:

- Paint (watercolor, tempera, poster, acrylic, etc.)
- Drawing materials (pencil, charcoal, colored chalk, pastels, markers, etc)
- Prints (handmade stencils, gadget printing, collographs, block prints, etc)

The artwork must measure no larger than 17 x 12 inches. Limit of one entry per participant.

All artworks must be original ideas and created entirely by the student. No artwork depicting characters from television shows, movies, video games, or books will be accepted.

Judging and Winners

- A panel of judges from the Library, Culture and Arts commission will review the entries.
- A finalist will be selected from each of the following groups: ages 5-7, ages 8-10, ages 11-13.
- Finalist prizes include art books, art supplies and gift cards.

Finalists will be notified by phone and will be presented with a certificate and a prize at the April Library, Culture, & Arts Commission meeting.
