

The “Justice for All” Award Poster Contest: What is the Face of Fentanyl Contest Rules

All Santa Clara County high school students are invited to submit their work by **Friday, May 6, 2022**. Winners will be announced on **Monday, May 23, 2022** on the District Attorney’s [website](#), [Facebook](#), and [Twitter](#).

All entrants who do not place will be mailed a Starbucks gift card. The first-place winner will receive \$1,500 and their work will be prominently published on the District Attorney’s website and other venues. The second-place winner will receive \$1,000, and the third-place winner will receive \$500. The top three winners will receive their prizes at an awards ceremony at a later date.

Contest Details

Rules

- One submission per student artist.
- Submissions must be 24” x 36”, or 22” x 28”.
- The student artist must currently reside in Santa Clara County and be actively enrolled in a Santa Clara County high school.
- The work must be original and the sole product of the student.
- No use of copyright or trademarked images.
- No use of profanity.
- The top three winners must complete an Authorization for Use of Image.
- Family members of employees of the Santa Clara County District Attorney's Office are excluded from participation.

Submission Options and Instructions

Submit your poster by **Friday, May 6, 2022**, using **one** of the following methods:

 - a. Include your name and the name of your high school in the file name.
(Ex. “Jane_Doe_Santa_Clara_HS_Fentanyl_Posters.PNG”)
 - b. Include “Justice for All Poster Submission” in the subject line.
 - c. The body of the email must include: the student’s full name, email address, home address, grade, and name of high school.
