This is a three credit hour course that includes the following topics:

- History and Political Ecology of Indonesia



- Flora and fauna of the rainforests- ecology and conservation
- Socioeconomics and rural livelihood around the protected areas



- Palm oil monoculture and its impact on rainforest ecosystems
- Community-based eco-tourism, antipoaching, and conservation

The class will visit different protected areas, religious and cultural sites, and the rainforests that serve as a classroom to learn diverse wildlife and habitats, unique landscapes, and religion, culture, & socioeconomic issues in biodiversity conservation of the region
