

Junior Ambassador Requirements:

- Be a Full Time undergraduate Tarleton Student in the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources
- Maintain a 2.75GPA
- Members must demonstrate the highest level of leadership
- All Social Media outlets must uphold Tarleton's Core Values
- Attend college leadership and degree trainings
- All content published to social media pages on the Universities behalf must be approved by the acting advisor or college media Coordinator
- Attend every meeting
- Attend at least 5 events per year (3 hour minimum)
