Board members are expected to attend monthly meetings, serve on a committee, support fundraising efforts, and act as ambassadors for LBFE's mission.

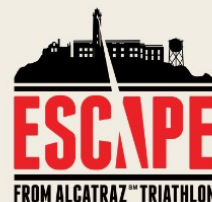
This is a meaningful opportunity to help reduce isolation and loneliness among older adults in San Francisco while working with a dynamic, dedicated team.
