HOW TO BECOME A CONSUMER

Step 1: Referral

Step 2: Schedule Appointment

- An appointment to meet with an Advocate will be scheduled

Step 3: Intake

- Person-centered approach to develop consumer goals (proof of disability and identification required)

Step 4: Assistance

- Advocate will assist consumer with goal(s) and/or provide information/referrals for resources

FIVE CORE SERVICES

Advocacy: MHI provides information and assistance to people with disabilities and their families in accessing support systems, and promoting changes that enhance full access to the community.

Peer Support: MHI provides a forum for individuals and their families to obtain a greater understanding of disability issues and their solutions.

Information and Referral: Comprehensive and current information on resources for people with disabilities is provided. Referrals are given for services such as: housing, education and attendant assistance services.

Independent Living Skills Training: MHI offers individuals basic training in skills that empower them to live more independently (i.e., cooking, money management, transit training, etc.).

Youth Transition: As youth with disabilities transition from school into a new level of independence, MHI provides supports, information, advocacy and recreational activities.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Transportation Services: MHI assists residents in Galveston County with transportation needs such as identifying current transportation providers fixed and demand response services, travel training, and mobility management.

Social and Recreational: MHI provides regularly scheduled activities for people with disabilities to socialize, be creative and avoid isolation.

Barrier Reduction: Assisting individuals and the community to be aware of physical and attitudinal barriers that prevent full inclusion of people with disabilities.

Employment Services: Vocational training, such as interviewing skills, resume preparation and job-seeking skills is provided to encourage employment.

Volunteerism: MHI provides volunteer opportunities to people with disabilities that offer workplace training and peer support.

Mobility Management: MHI assists residents in Galveston County with improving access to transportation services in the county by connecting them to current transportation services, providing travel training, and purchasing transportation services to fulfill gaps in services.
