History

Wesley Chapel Mission Center, located at 76 East McMicken Avenue in Over-the-Rhine, is an extension ministry of the United Methodist Church. It was created from the assets, resources, efforts, dreams, and love of the members of the former Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church. In 2003, it was established as a non-profit 501(c)3 providing an after-school program for children.

Wesley Chapel Mission Center lives out the legacy of the church, which was a servant church started in Cincinnati in 1802. It continues the practice of loving Jesus and serving others in our Over-the-Rhine community of Cincinnati.



After-School Programs

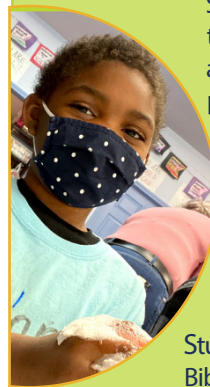
Primary

Monday-Friday (2 pm-5 pm)

High energy, after school care designed to empower PreK-2nd grade students to succeed at school and beyond. Each day students receive homework help, engage in academic activities, learn about Jesus, participate in enrichment activities, and eat a hearty snack. They also participate in monthly community service projects and enrichment events.

Middle School

Monday-Friday (2 pm-5 pm)



Students in 3rd-6th grade gather each day to receive homework help, engage in academic activities, learn about Jesus, participate in enrichment activities, and eat a hearty snack. They also participate in monthly community service projects and enrichment events.

High School

Monday-Friday (2:30pm-6 pm)

Students in 7th-12th grade study the Bible, receive homework assistance, learn life skills, discover post-high school options, and enjoy fellowship as well as a hearty snack. Students plan and perform monthly community service projects, explore jobs through on-site visits, and college tours.

A job program which allows active participants in our high school program to apply, interview and be hired to work at WCMC.

Science, Technology, Arithmetic, and Reading

Saturday (10:30am-12:30pm)

Academic assistance to give children in grades PreK-12th the fundamental blocks of knowledge necessary to succeed in school. Each student's work is customized to balance remedial and challenging work.

Super Saturday

Saturday (12:30pm-3:00pm)

This fun afternoon event is planned and implemented by groups or volunteers. Children and the volunteers enjoy lunch, crafts, games, and other activities.

Summer Camp

Primary & Middle

Monday-Friday (12:00pm-3:30pm)

Summer camp is open to children who have completed PreK-6th grade and runs for six weeks each summer.

Program provides:

Academic instruction, a healthy lunch, enriching activities, gardening, discovery trips, and instruction in God's Word.

High School

Monday-Friday (12:00pm-3:30pm)

Designed for students who have completed 7th-12th grade. It offers them safe, productive activities to do for six weeks of the summer.

Program provides:

College tours, a healthy lunch, job shadowing, gardening, discovery trips, and continued Christian and academic education.
