

CATEGORIES FOR THE 2020-21 58th Altrusa Art Fair

Categories listed below are those suggested by Art Teachers and Judging Artists.

1. Painting – Oil, acrylic watercolor, gouache, casein, tempera or airbrush
2. Drawing/Color – Colored pencils, colored inks, oil pastels, markers, pastels and crayons.
3. Drawing/Black & White – Charcoal, pen and ink, pencil.
4. Mixed Media – Two or media, incorporating any number of materials with a 3D elements including collage.
5. Print Making – Any form of printmaking i.e. etching, lithograph, intaglio, silk screen, woodcut, mono prints, etc.
6. Sculpture – Modeled, carved, cast, constructed or assembled, relief.
7. Photography - Black & White.
8. Photography – Color including selective color, monochromatic photos.
9. Computer enhanced photography – Photos that have been heavily manipulated by the computer to produce a new image.
10. Digital Art – Computer generated art work.
11. Video, Film and Animation – Projects of an experimental, abstract, or narrative nature.
12. Design: Editorial Design – Art for commercial or applied purposes. Design includes work that has a defined use such as advertising, communication or product design, i.e. greeting cards, fonts, letterhead, business cards, etc.
13. Comic Art – A pictorial narrative in deliberate sequence – with or without text- that tells a story or develops an idea through use of a single or multiple panels, i.e. comic strips, comic books, storyboards, etc.
14. Ceramics/Functional – teapots, cups, vessels that are useable.
15. Ceramics/Nonfunctional – Clay sculptures
16. Jewelry & Metalsmithing – Pendants, rings, brooches, etc. and copper tooling.
17. Textile & Fiber Art – Fabric, fiber, hand-made paper, reeds, batik and stitch.
18. Glass – Stained glass or etched glass.
19. Collaborative Projects – Any art piece that is the work of more than one student.
20. Scratch boards – Middle school only.
