COVID-19 Procedures
As of Monday, February 7, 2022

What happens when there is a positive case?

- Isolation guidance:
 - The positive individual will stay home for 5 days from symptom onset.
 - If symptom free, they may return to school on day 6.
 - You should continue to wear a mask for 5 additional days.
 - If feverish on day 5, they must stay home until 24 hours symptom free.
- 1-5 positive cases. within 10 days:
 - Families will receive an email with the case total.
 - Class/grade will be monitored for symptoms.
 - Students and staff will not have to quarantine.
- After 5 positive cases within 10 days:
 - Families will receive an email with the case total.
 - Unvaccinated students and staff:
 - Quarantine for 5 days at home.
 - On day 6, if you are symptom-free it is highly recommended that you get tested** and wear a mask for 5 additional days.
 - If any symptoms develop, follow our illness process.
 - Non-symptomatic fully vaccinated students, staff, and those who have tested positive for COVID in the past 90 days are not required to quarantine.
 - On day 6, if you are symptom-free it is highly recommended that you get tested and wear a mask for 5 additional days.
 - If any symptoms develop, follow our illness process.
