All artwork is due by November 4<sup>th</sup> (Monday) as teachers and staff will vote on the winners during our morning staff meeting Tuesday, November 5<sup>th</sup>.

## ~Requirements and Ideas for the Back Cover~

The back cover has to feature the words Holy Family Catholic School or HFCS and the school year 2019-2020. Your design needs to fill the entire 8.5x11 paper I give you. Must be created individually, *no group efforts* – I cannot assess who is doing what work outside the art room - credit goes where credit is due. Yearbook back covers should incorporate the elements that has made Holy Family unique and special to you! Additional ideas: our school's mascot (the Falcon), image of the Holy Family (St. Joseph, Mary, and Jesus), little sketches filling the space with all the sports, subjects, activities, etc. offered here at HFCS, the words that we strive to show every day (Empathy, Positivity, Gratitude, and Courage) etc. If you are struggling coming up with ideas, come talk to Mrs. Benedict.
