STUDENT PLEDGE FOR TECHNOLOGY USE

1. I will take good care of my iPad, Chromebook or laptop.
2. I will never leave my device unattended.
3. I will never loan out my device to other individuals.
4. I will know where my device is at all times.
5. I will charge my device's battery every evening and bring it to school every day.
6. I will keep food and beverages away from my device since they may cause damage.
7. I will not disassemble any part of my device or attempt any repairs.
8. I will protect my device by only carrying it while in the case provided.
9. I will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by neglect or abuse.
10. I will use my device in ways that are appropriate, meet Oakbrook Preparatory School expectations and are educational.
11. I will use the device still camera, video camera, airdrop or audio recorder only when directed by a teacher.
12. I will use social media apps and messaging apps (i.e. Messages, Facetime, Skype) only when directed by a teacher.
13. I understand that when my device is in use at school, the teacher or school personnel has the right to inspect the device.
14. I understand that when my device is in use outside of school, my parents/guardians have the right to inspect the device.
15. Misuse of the device could result in suspension of use of this device at school.
16. I agree not to view, listen to, or share inappropriate content. Specifically I will not access movies, music, games or apps with a MA, N-17 or R rating.
17. I will adhere to copyright laws, licensing agreements, and conditions of use.
18. I will not use inflammatory, derogatory, threatening, or obscene language or pictures, impersonate others, or repost comments without permission from the original sender.
19. I will refrain from playing games on my device from during the school day and will not be using it in the halls when walking to and from class.
