



SCHOOL UPDATE 2020-2021

FBCD WEEKDAY PRESCHOOL SAFETY PROTOCOLS

Drop Off /Pick Up Procedures

- No parents or visitors will be allowed into preschool hall.
- Parents or guardians will drop off/ pick up children at carpool lane in staggering time.
- Temperatures (both student and a parent/guardian in the car) will be taken in the morning: students exhibiting symptoms may not attend school. Temperature check may happen randomly during school hours.
- Health screening questions will be asked each day.
- If a student becomes sick during school hour, he/she will be sent to an isolation room until a parent/guardian come to pick up.
- Parents must clearly label the child's items in a tote bag. No backpacks allowed.

Classroom Practices

- 20 seconds hand washing will be reinforced as students come into the classroom in the morning and as coming back from playground, before snack & meal time, after bathroom use, and any time as needed.
- Each class may use 2 classrooms to give appropriate social distancing. One classroom will be for circle time with less furniture to give more space between students on carpet with sit spots. And the other room will have desks and chairs for table activities and meal time. We are planning to assign less children at a table for social distancing. Centers & play area will be located possibly in both rooms accordingly.
- Classes will utilize more outdoor spaces when possible.
- Large group gathering-programs & events are postponed indefinitely.
- Students use individual sets of supplies.

Face Masks

- Any adult at carpool area or preschool hallway must wear a mask &/or face shield.
- Masks are not recommended for children 2s & under per AAP & CDC recommendations.
- 3's & 4's may wear a mask but not required to do so.
- Parents who choose for their student to wear a mask must send multiple masks daily in case of any incident.
- Weekday staff must wear a clear mask and face shield.

Facilities & Cleaning

- Water fountains will not be used.
- All classrooms and bathrooms will undergo cleaning before & after use.
- Toys, counters, doorknobs, tables, chairs and any common area will be sanitized daily & between times.
- The church custodial staff will increase sanitization practice with certified COVID-19 cleaning equipment.
