Hospital Bed Addition:

- 26 single inpatient rooms with personal washrooms and floor to ceiling windows

New technologies

- Automated medication distribution system (first rural hospital in Manitoba to have this system)
- Emergency department information System (EDIS) to help manage patient flow

- 18,000 sq.ft. single storey addition

- Increase in size from 2400 to 7800 sq. ft

ASHERN All Our Relations Smudging and Ceremony Room



All Our Relations spiritual care space has upgraded lighting and ventilation for smudging. It is a place to benefit all people who pass through the facility's doors, respecting the spiritual and cultural practices of First Nations and Métis people who attend Ashern's Lakeshore General Hospital.



ASHERN Personal Care Home Sprinkler Update

Since Feb. 3 installation of a fire suppression sprinkler system has been ongoing in Ashern Personal Care Home. This work required access to the ceiling throughout the facility to install heat and smoke activated sprinklers.

The project is being completed in eight phases and is expected to conclude this summer.



ERIKSDALE E.M. Crowe Memorial Hospital ED Renovation

The project, currently in the schematic design phase, represents a significant investment in the future of local healthcare services. The project is scheduled to go to tender in late Fall 2025.

Renovation is expected to begin during the Winter 2025/2026 season, pending the successful completion of ongoing work at the hospital in Ashern.

It is anticipated the project will be completed in spring of 2027.

Earlier this year, a public survey generated 142 responses and in-person information sessions on March 6, 2025 saw approximately 150 staff members, physicians and members of the public share their thoughts on the project to renovate the existing ED in Eriksdale. In addition, first nation leaders from the areas serviced by the hospital were consulted on the project as part of its commitment to community involvement. The project team—comprised of design professionals and key stakeholders—will host a second round of public engagement sessions in August 2025. These sessions will provide community members with an opportunity to review the updated design, share feedback, and ask questions.
