Dr. Ursina Krumpholz is the new Minister Counselor and Head of the Economic Business Section of the German Embassy in Washington D.C. as of August 1st, 2017.

Prior to joining the German Embassy, Dr. Krumpholz held various positions in the Federal Ministry of Economic Affairs and Energy, including a secondment to the Federal Republic of Germany's mission in Geneva. Her focus has consistently remained on foreign trade, sanctions in particular, WTO, export credit insurance and investment guarantees as well as investment protection.

Dr. Krumpholz studied law in Tübingen, Aix-en-Provence and Freiburg in Breisgau. After completing her second state exam in law, she also completed a doctoral thesis on the principle of equality in French administrative and constitutional law, before working as a legal counsellor with Heidelberger Druckmaschinen AG.
