


Please wear a mask

Wearing masks has been proven to be highly effective in reducing the spread of COVID-19. Don't have a mask? Call the agency ahead of time and they will bring one for you.

Practice social distancing

Please remember to stay a safe distance (at least 6 feet) from workers while they are not providing hands-on care.

Home care workers are authorized to leave the home if they believe the environment is unsafe. You can help keep the environment safe by wearing a mask! Failure on the part of clients and families to use masks may impact future care.
