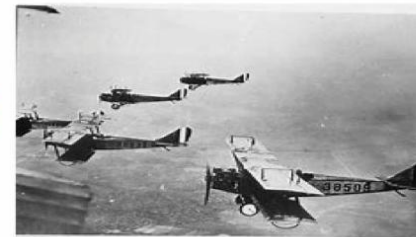

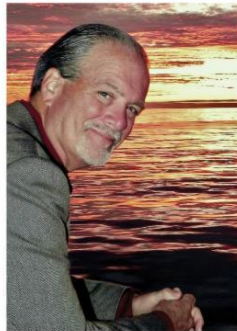

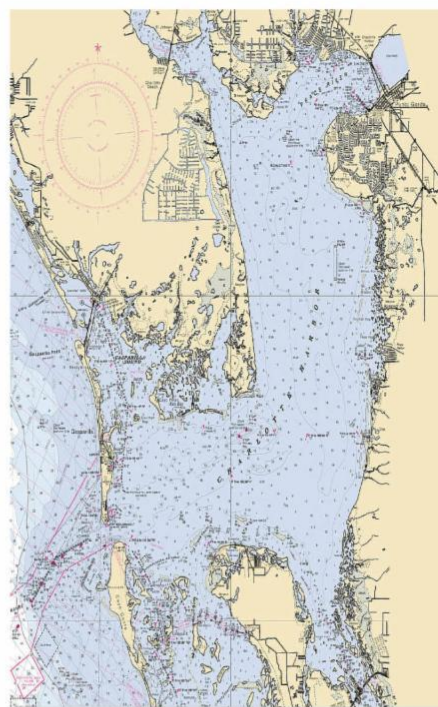

### BASIC NAVIGATION COURSE

This is a beginner course for basic skills in reading and interpreting a Nautical Chart (you will be provided with a waterproof Charlotte Harbor Chart), what the symbols on your chart mean, and the rules of the road in navigation coastal areas. You will learn the difference between True Course, Magnetic Variation and Compass Deviation and how to plot a course, Dead Reckoning, and how to get a fix. There is also a segment about GPS and how the system works.

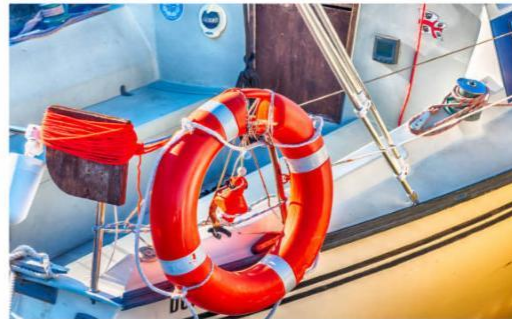

### BOAT SAFETY COURSE

**BOAT AMERICA** (Boating Safety Course) This course is required by law for anyone born on or after January 1, 1988, to operate a powerboat or PWC. This is a seven to eight hour course from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Upon completion of the class instruction there will be a sixty question examination, and upon successful completion of the examination in approximately two and half weeks you will receive a permanent lifetime plastic card from Florida Fish and Wildlife. The course is an introduction to safe boating, boating laws and regulations, personal safety and the safety of your passengers, the type and use of safety equipment, trailering, storing of your boat, protecting your boat, recreational usage, ability to identify the Aids to Navigation (ATON) and the rules of the road and proper techniques of anchoring and securing your boat at the dock. If you own a boat, take the plastic card or certificate to your boat insurance agent for a possible discount on your boat insurance.



Classes are held at the Military Heritage Museum, 900 West Marion Avenue, Punta Gorda, Florida, in the Museum Library. Parking is in the lot under the building, take the elevator to the second floor, turn right and right again to the library. For those who are attending a Boat America class you should bring lunch and eat it in the outside dining area or on the first-floor cafe area. All drinks must be covered. You will be given a 45-minute lunch break.

## VETERANS HISTORY PROJECT

### MILITARY HERITAGE MUSEUM

#### *Create a Memory*



The United States Congress created the Veterans History Project (VHP) in 2000 as part of the American Folklife Center at the Library of Congress. VHP collects, preserves and makes accessible the firsthand remembrances of military veterans from World War I through the more recent conflicts.

#### Deceased Veterans

Next of kin of deceased veterans may donate original photographs, letters, diaries and unpublished memoirs of a deceased veteran, and must submit the Biographical Data Form and a Veteran's Release form on behalf of the deceased veteran. The collection must meet the minimum collection standards.



#### Gold Star Families

Under the Gold Star Families Voices Act (Public Law 114-246), VHP accepts oral histories by immediate family members (parent, spouse, sibling or child) of members of the Armed Forces who died as a result of their service during a period of war. Due to the sensitive nature of the Gold Star oral histories, the Veterans History Project requires a minimum age of 18 for both the interviewers and interviewees.



#### Group Participants

In addition to individual volunteers, the Veterans History Project accepts collections from organizations around the country interested in participating in a grassroots community project. They include high school, university and college classrooms; libraries; veterans service organizations; places of worship; retirement communities; Scout troops; local businesses; and professional associations.

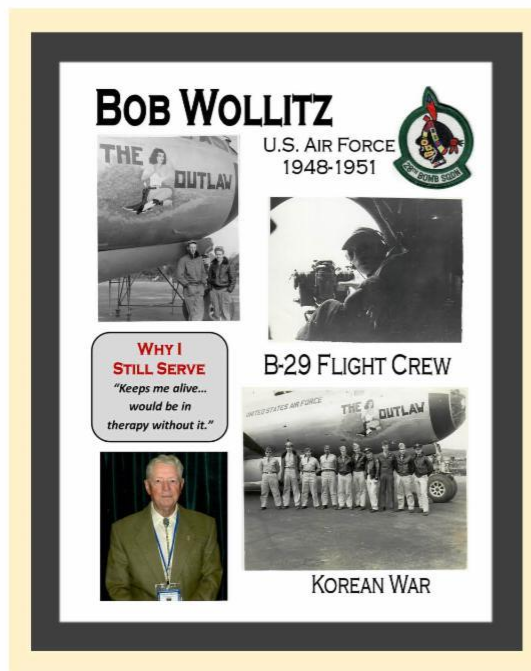

"My father never told me about his time overseas. He never talked about his military service." You hear these words every day from our museum visitors. "Why we Still Serve. Veteran Storytellers of the Military Heritage Museum" is a project dedicated to the 100 plus volunteer veterans of the Military Heritage Museum who, by using a variety of interpretive methods—some unique and unusual—have found storytelling to be a personal therapeutic experience. An experience that not only enables them to share their stories but also creates a safe space for visiting veterans and families of veterans to also share theirs.

Under the guidance of a certified Oral Historian, this project will tell their story through a dedicated exhibit, videos, and public discussion on the effectiveness of storytelling as it relates to helping veterans confront their fears, expressing their military experience. The project's outcome is to share with the public a deeper understanding of the museum volunteers.

We see this discussion as an educational opportunity to help other veterans "find the words", enabling them to tell their story to family and friends. Studies have indicated that veterans demonstrate a higher rate of volunteerism than non-veterans.

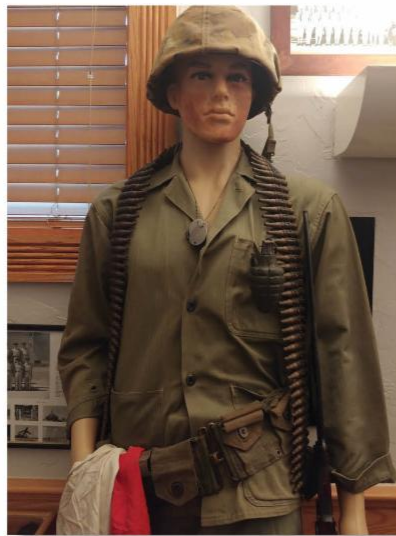

DOUGHBOY UNIFORM

The First World War was fought from 1914 to 1918 and the Second World War was fought from 1939 to 1945. They were the largest military conflicts in human history. Both wars involved military alliances between different groups of countries. So, there were two World Wars...but what was life like for the soldiers of each war? How did warfare change? What new technologies drove the change?

Through February 4th, the Military Heritage Museum offers a special exhibit in the museum atrium titled "The World Wars: Doughboys of WW1 and GIs of WW2", which seeks to show how the life of soldiers differed from WW1 to WW2. The exhibit will examine how warfare changed over the course of both wars; and what advancements in military technology drove these changes. The soldiers' ability to adapt and survive in the harshest conditions is a quality shared by soldiers in every theater of war.

Through artifacts and videos this exhibit will show how battlefield life differed for soldiers in both the World Wars. See and hear the heroic tales of the WW1 Doughboys and the WW2 GIs at the Military Heritage Museum.

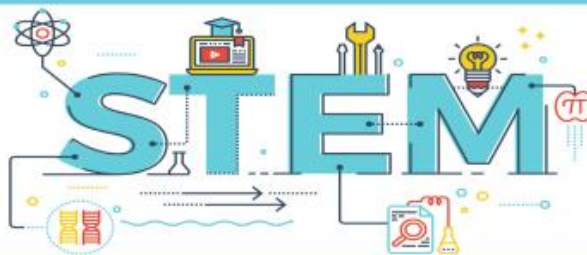
