Luckily, for Zeus, while it took 5 months, a wonderful family recently welcomed this sweet gentle giant into their family. These are the very best days.



Sometimes when I sit at my desk and I look into my friends' eyes, I wonder what they're thinking. Do they wonder why they're here and when the family they had so many years will come back to get them? Are they better off and more loved here with us?

Hunter Lee loves to ride in the car, so he often gets to go on the bank runs with me. When I crack the window open, he sticks his nose out and takes in all the new smells that he misses living in the shelter. Sometimes, when I watch him get excited on our drives, I wonder if he thinks I'm taking him back to his home. I wonder if we are driving right by the place where he lived for so many years, the place that was home. My heart hurts for him, and I give him extra pets while we ride down the road. Then, when we get to the drive through he knows he's going to get his bank treat. His eyes are so hopeful. He thinks it's a great day – he doesn't worry like I do.
