Carol loves turtles of all kinds, especially sea turtles, and volunteers as an FWC-permitted sea turtle monitor with Coastal Wildlife Club. She is a member of the <u>Sea Turtle Stranding and Salvage Network (STSSN)</u>, <u>International Sea Turtle Society (ISTS)</u>, and <u>Gopher Tortoise Council</u>, for which she is the outreach coordinator for SWFL. As an Advanced Florida Master Naturalist, Carol teaches others about Florida's unique ecosystems and wildlife. Carol has traveled the world to see sea turtles and learn more about them.

Carol is a founding member of the Friends of Stump Pass (FOSP), a division of Barrier Island Parks Society (BIPS). The all-volunteer group works to preserve nature and protect wildlife while connecting people to the unspoiled beauty of Stump Pass Beach State Park. Carol currently serves as its chairperson and leads the FOSP "Sea Turtles Everywhere!" program held twice monthly at Stump Pass Beach State Park during sea turtle nesting season.
