



Dear KM members,

We have been feeling angry and hurt, alone and unprotected and many of us have also been feeling helpless. NOT ANY MORE! There's a way for us to help our Israeli brothers and sisters.

KM has adopted the soldiers of 92111, Omer Rahamim, the Golani Unit of the IDF. Please view the videos to hear their messages of appreciation. They need our help with supplies while they protect the land of Israel and search for and bring home hostages. Thanks to Adinah Finn and a non profit organization called Maman, KM members and friends of KM can take action quickly and easily.

There are three ways to support KM's adopted IDF unit:

1. Make a tax-deductible contribution directly to Maman. Once on the website, select the drop-down menu for Kehillat Ma'arav. One hundred percent of your donation will be used to purchase items for KM's adopted troop and/or
2. Purchase items on the Amazon wish list. Items are put on the list by the IDF on an as needed basis. The Golani unit needs the following items: *robocop knee pads, thick socks, heaters, heat bags, thick socks, Leatherman's wave plus, tactical uniforms, tactical helmets, mountain shoes, men's rain pants, face masks, packable rain jacket, ear plugs, shooting glasses, space heaters and anything else the troop requests.* Everything on the list is guaranteed to be up to the standard required for the IDF.
  - a. When selecting the shipping information, please choose "**Manan Encino**" so the items are sent to Adinah's house.
  - b. Once there is a bulk of items received, KM members (and friends) will be invited to Adinah's home for a Havdalah packing party. We will unpack Amazon boxes, repack for the troop and will be able to include handwritten letters to our adopted soldiers in the suitcases we send.
  - c. Once we complete the needs of the Golani Unit, we can adopt another Troop. This is an ongoing project as long as they need us, we will be there.
3. Share this information on your social media and ask friends to support KM's troops. I will be able to give weekly updates about KM's success in meeting the need of our adopted Troop(s).

Maman works with the IDF and El Al Airlines to assure these items reach the IDF troops.
