# TICKETS

**TICKETS WILL BE REQUIRED OF ALL PERSONS AGE 23+ AND WILL BE CHECKED AT THE DOOR.**

Members of Kehillat Ma'arav will receive one ticket per adult once their membership renewal has been received.

We ask that all non-members of our community support our congregation and the increasing cost of yearly High Holiday services by contributing through ticket purchases as follows:

- Non-member: \$300 per adult
- Relative of a KM member: \$150 per adult
- College students, military, first responders (with ID): Complimentary
- Members receiving reciprocity from other synagogues: Complimentary

You may purchase tickets on our website or by calling our office at 310-829-0566. They can be sent via USPS, picked up at the KM office, or picked up at "will call" upon arrival at the check-in table.

At this time of year, we want to open our doors and encourage non-members to experience the benefits of affiliating with Kehillat Ma'arav. **NO ONE WILL BE DENIED ADMISSION TO HIGH HOLIDAY SERVICES BECAUSE OF A GENUINE INABILITY TO PAY THE SUGGESTED CONTRIBUTION.**

Tickets are for all five days of the holidays and are not provided on a service-by-service basis.

Members at other synagogues, regardless of affiliation, may request reciprocity in advance. They are given GUEST TICKETS and may attend at no cost. We recommend planning your arrival 30 minutes before services begin to avoid congestion in the garage and ensure you can be checked in and seated in a timely fashion.
