General Rules and Reminders

1. All lots are offered and sold “as is.” Please check items carefully before you bid. All sales are final.
2. Unless otherwise specified, all auction items and services must be used within the time frame given in the item’s description or one year. Unless stated otherwise, dates and times are to be arranged at the mutual convenience of the donor and the winning bidder.
3. At the end of the evening, you will receive a list of winning items you’ve bid on. You may pay by cash or check at the entrance table. If you wish to use a credit card, please text “Tuxedo” to 73256 on your mobile phone (note that credit card fees are paid by St. Mary’s; you will see an option to cover them). After you’ve paid, show your online receipt to the entrance table to receive your item.

Live Auction

1. Your paddle should be in the event envelope you received upon arrival. An individual paddle number has been assigned to each bidder and should be used for the live portion of the auction.
2. When bidding, please raise your paddle high in the air so the auctioneers and spotters can clearly see you.
3. The highest bidder shall be the buyer, after the lot’s reserve price has been met, if applicable. The Event Committee shall designate the reserve price for each lot.

A 1967 Willys CJ5A Tuxedo Park Edition Mark IV Jeep, the last year of production. Original in every detail, a V6 engine with 8,000 original miles, 3 speed floor shift, 4-wheel drive. It lived in California until 15 years ago when Clem bought it and brought it east.

More about the Jeep from Clem: "The search for a Tuxedo Park Jeep started when I moved into the Park with my wife Valerie and our three children. That was in 1977, fully three decades before this Jeep was found. In fairness, the search did not always have my full attention, but it was always there in the background. My requirements were strict. The Jeep had to be; totally original and not restored; perfect mechanical and physical condition; no history of accidents; very low miles; a one owner vehicle; always garaged; and preferably from a warm, dry climate. A tall order, which explains the lengthy search. After many disappointments, there it was. On eBay of all places. I corresponded with the owner, who happened to be a broker who had just acquired it from an estate. While not the original owner, it was close enough. The photographs and conversations convinced me that all of the boxes were checked and this was finally the one. We agreed on a price. Then the seller got cold feet and took the Jeep off the market. He said that he wanted to convert it into a dune buggy which were popular in California at the time. I literally pleaded with him that I lived in Tuxedo Park and that it was the namesake of the Jeep. He had a warm spot for my plea and we continued with the sale at the same previously agreed price. There was one caveat. He wanted two live New England Lobsters. The Jeep was shipped from CA to RI in a covered semi. When it arrived, I was thrilled beyond expectation. Except, all of the brake components were nonfunctional. So I never did send the lobsters."
