



K-12 Student Quarantine Classroom Guidance



Public Health - Dayton & Montgomery County recommends that K-12 schools amend their quarantine procedures to allow that those students, faculty and staff that may have been exposed to a person with COVID-19 in a classroom setting or on school provided buses, do not need to self-quarantine, provided that the exposure took place in the classroom and all parties were properly wearing face masks.

The above exception ***does not apply to sports or extra-curricular activities.***

All other exposure should follow the standard quarantine procedures. Those exposed, but not quarantined, should continue to monitor themselves for symptoms for 14 days and initiate a self-isolation if any symptoms develop.
