The NAVCA Awards - FAQs

Who can enter the NAVCA Awards?

The Awards are open to NAVCA members only. Our members do all kinds of amazing work all over the country and we wanted an event that celebrates and showcases our member's achievements and helps to tell the story of local social infrastructure.

How many categories can I enter?

You can submit an entry into as many categories as you wish!

Will there be an awards ceremony?

Yes, the ceremony will be held at The St Brides Foundation, London on 19 March. Tickets are free.

What will happen at the Awards Ceremony?

From 4pm we are holding a 'What's new to NAVCA?' event where attendees can mingle with NAVCA staff and trustees, tell us what your priorities are as part of the movement and hear about our vision over the next 12 months. From 5pm we are holding a drinks reception, leading on to the Awards Ceremony from 6pm.

What do you win?

As this is the first time we are holding the awards, we are focussing on the work of our Members. Winners will receive a certificate and are able to promote their status as the winner of a NAVCA Award however they see fit. There will be a wide scale promotion of winners and shortlisted entries across our communication platforms. We will also be running a special edition of our quarterly 'In Practice' publication focusing on the winners' stories.

How do I submit my entry?

For all entries you should submit up to 300 words and a video of up to 2minutes [here](#). If you are shortlisted, your video will be shared across NAVCA communication platforms, including our website. We don't expect a Steven Spielberg blockbuster, you could record something on your mobile phone; as long as it supports your entry and tells us about your organisation, we will be happy to accept it!

When is the deadline for submission?

Midnight, Sunday 24 February 2019.

Why are we doing it?

Because you all do amazing things every day, let's celebrate it!
