Please review <u>By-Law 2022-08</u> for updated tipping fees that came into effect on January 1st, 2023.


Please Note: A \$30 freon removal fee will be charged for items such as fridges, freezers, air conditioners etc.

Landfill Life Expectancy - Site 9

In 2024 our staff and Azimuth Environmental Consulting completed mandatory site inspections and reports. In 2024 approximately 500m³ of waste was disposed of at our landfill. This is at the low end of the previous 5-year annual range of 500-2,300m³, and lower than the previous 5-year average of 1,100m³. Our measurements indicate there is approximately 19,000m³ of capacity remaining, which corresponds to an estimated landfill life expectancy of 17 years.

Payment Methods at Transfer Stations and Site 9

Payment methods available to residents and contractors are PayPal (via QR Code), Waste Tags, and a debit terminal (Site 9 only). Cash is no longer accepted for fee items; fees must be paid using one of the three payment methods mentioned above. Waste Tags are \$2.50 per tag and must be purchased in advance and provided to the attendant upon waste disposal. Waste tags are available for purchase in advance at the Township office, Holiday Cove Marina, and Site 9. When using PayPal, we recommend you download the PayPal app and create an account prior to going to Site 9 or the transfer stations to save yourself time. The preferred method of payment at Site 9 Landfill is the debit terminal. All fees must be paid at time of disposal. Contractors can still use the billing system for disposal at Site 9.



FoodCycler Program



The Archipelago subsidized a successful FoodCycler program in 2023 and 2024 in which 312 units were sold to residents to support wet organics waste diversion. FoodCyclers are still available for purchase at a subsidized rate, with delivery direct from the supplier to residents, at fcs-events.com/foodcycler-archipelago. In 2023, 92 tonnes of organic waste were diverted from the landfill and 57 tonnes of equivalent carbon dioxide greenhouse gas emissions were subsequently reduced.



Clear Plastic Bags

The Archipelago is committed to operating safe and efficient recycling and waste facilities. The Township adopted a "clear bag program" as a cost-effective measure to increase the diversion of recyclable materials from the waste stream. Additionally, the implementation of a clear bag program improves worker safety as they can conduct a quick assessment of the contents and ensure that there are no hazardous items inside that could cause injury. It is therefore mandatory that all household garbage and/or recyclables be placed in clear plastic bags. Open recycling containers are also acceptable.

Waste Disposal Cards

All users of the Township's recycling and waste disposal facilities must present a waste disposal card to the attendant. If you are a new owner of property in the Township and require a card, or require a replacement card, please call the Township Office at 705-746-4243 Ext. 341. You may also submit a Service Request on the Township's website at thearchipelago.ca. Please note that waste cards do not have an expiry date. When submitting a request for a waste disposal card, kindly specify whether you require only a digital version to be emailed to you or if you would like to receive both a hard copy and a digital copy.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

The Township of The Archipelago has an agreement with the Town of Parry Sound for Archipelago residents to dispose of household hazardous waste at the MacFarlane Street Transfer Station, located at 57 MacFarlane Street in Parry Sound. Commercial hazardous waste is not accepted.

Acceptable Items

Please visit the <u>Township's</u> <u>website</u> for more information regarding the accepted items, such as recycling, scrap metal, electronic waste, tires, brush, etc. at each transfer station, as not all transfer stations accept the same items.
