
COVID-19 TK-12 DECISION TREE (2.2.2022) to Determine Isolation or Quarantine





- ANYTIME a test is **positive** (regardless of vaccination status or absence of symptoms), <u>isolate at home</u> for ≥5 days after any symptoms began (or date positive test collected) <u>and</u> no fever for ≥24 hours <u>and</u> until symptoms improve.
- 2. <u>All FDA-approved COVID tests can be used for diagnosis or to end isolation/quarantine.</u> (<u>Antigen preferred to end isolation.</u>) <u>Staff & students may be required to verify at-home test results.</u>
- 3. **Close contact**=<6 feet from *a confirmed case* for ≥15 minutes (can be multiple short-duration exposures) over a 24-hour period, beginning 2 days before the case was infectious.
- 4. **NO**= **Age 18**+ who received initial series & are booster-eligible but have **not yet received a booster**; unvaccinated students **YES**= Adults boosted <u>or</u> vaccinated but not yet booster eligible (dose too recent); anyone who had COVID-19 within the last 90 days; or anyone ages 5-17 who completed their initial series
- 5. If case is a **household member**, contacts <u>NOT</u> fully vaccinated (no/incomplete initial series) follow standard quarantine for ≥5 days (10 days if untested) from the end of the case's isolation.
