

Provincial Tax on Toastmasters Membership Dues

Please note the following important information:

- 1. Effective **August 4, 2025**, all sales transactions—including membership dues, new member fees, new paths, charter fees, all other digitally delivered items, and tangible goods will be subject to the applicable sales tax rate. Notably, as a result, Toastmasters membership dues will be taxed based on the member's province of residence. Please check your inbox for an email from TI dated June 18 that outlines this change in detail.
- 2.TI will collect the applicable tax at the time of membership dues payment and remit it to the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA). Clubs that collect dues directly from their members should review their current dues structure and make any necessary adjustments to account for the tax.
- 3. At this time, according to TI:
- **Canada**: Taxes will be applied as of August 4, 2025, based on the province in which the member resides.
- **United States**: Some states already have tax applied. The TI system accounts for this.
- Other Countries: TI does not currently charge tax for members in other countries because either the sales thresholds haven't been met or there is no tax compliance requirement at this time.

PLEASE NOTE:

To **avoid being charged tax** on the upcoming membership dues in September:

- If members pay the **full 12-month dues** (October 2025 September 2026) **before August 4, 2025**, **no tax** will be applied for that period.
- If members only pay for 6 months (October 2025 March 2026) before
 August 4, no tax will apply to that payment. However, tax will be
 charged on the next renewal (April September 2026), as it will occur
 after the effective date.

We encourage all clubs to consider collecting dues for the full 12 months in advance, if possible, to avoid the additional tax charges and remit to TI before August 4, 2025.

• **New Requirement**: Clubs must complete and submit their Club Success Plan by September 30 to qualify for DCP recognition. Here is the link to the Club Success Plan template: **Toastmasters**

 - Maintain 25 or more members, and
 - Achieve all 10 DCP goals.



This year, our Toastmasters at TD club has doubled its membership by actively expanding our presence and engagement within the organization. As one of the internal clubs dedicated to employee development, we focused on raising awareness and showcasing the value of Toastmasters. We launched a dedicated internal social media page to share club news, member achievements, and communication tips from seasoned members —sparking interest and making it easy for curious employees to connect. We also collaborated with internal groups like the Black Employee Committee to introduce how Toastmasters supports career growth through communication and leadership skills. To further broaden our reach, we hosted engaging workshops and open houses every guarter featuring dynamic external speakers on topics like persuasive speaking and effective speech preparation, and even invited retired founding members to share their inspiring journeys. These combined efforts have not only enriched our community but also significantly increased participation and membership.

From Renewal to Revival: A Journey of Connection and Growth

When I became Vice President Membership at Inspiring Women Toastmasters on July1,2024, our club had dwindled to just 13 members. Determined to reverse that trend, I focused on making every meeting welcoming, safe and inspiring. Today, we're 32 members strong—a testament not only to my efforts but to every member who shows up week after week.

Between March and May 2025, we averaged ten inquiries per month. Of those, four guests attended a meeting and one joined—an impressive 25 percent conversion rate. I attribute this to consistency, clarity and care: I reply to inquiries within hours, follow up with new visitors within two hours, and reach out personally (often via WhatsApp) to nurture promising connections.

But true membership goes beyond recruitment. I regularly check in with members about their lives, dreams and challenges—not just their roles or speaking assignments. My goal is for members to feel seen, heard and supported. When renewal season arrives, I want them to choose to stay naturally, because they feel valued and connected.

This journey has taught me that membership isn't about headcounts—it's about building relationships. As we move forward, I'm confident our club will keep growing, not only in numbers but in heart.


