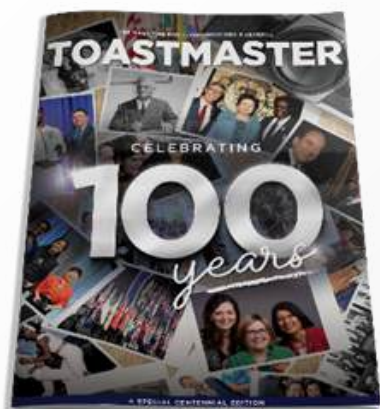
## Vibrant Club Officer Training Sessions

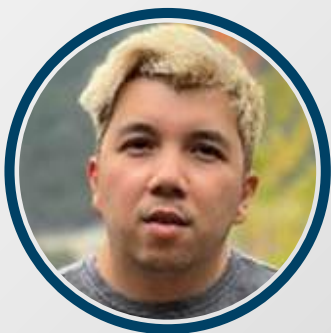
