As September unfolds, it's time to bring some "main things" into focus. What are they?

- Club Success Plan: Deadline: September 30. So far, 19 of our 104 clubs have submitted their plans. Since this is a mandatory requirement of the Distinguished Club Program, the District is launching a campaign with prizes for early submitters. Let's get off to the races!
- Membership Renewals: Deadline: September 30. About 800 members renewed before August 4, saving tax on membership dues. Eighteen clubs achieved 50%+ renewals through September 2026 and will each receive a \$25 gift certificate shortly. More prizes for early renewal await.
- Smedley Award: Deadline: September 30. Membership often dips during September renewals. Be sure to have membership drives at your clubs during this month, supported by District incentives and prizes.

Educational Program Changes are Coming!

The following updates were announced at the Annual Business Meeting held on August 22.

Effective Q4 this year:

- All Path levels will now include member participation requirements similar to the former Competent Communication (CL) through meeting roles.
- Advanced levels will require members to deliver modules from the Successful Club, Better Speaker, and Leadership Excellence Series.

Effective first half of 2026:

- Basic Training for Toastmasters (Ralph Smedley, 1940s) will be reintroduced as a Path in its original form, available for purchase in early 2026.
- New training materials, drawn from the Competent Communication and select Advanced manuals, will be released in 2026.



As we move into September, let us stay focused on the "main things" that drive our clubs and members forward. With the insights and inspiration gained from the International Convention, and the recognition of our District leaders' outstanding contributions, we are well-positioned to embrace the changes in the educational program and continue fostering growth.
