**Volunteer, Construction Contractor, and Partner Family Member  
Waiver and Release of Liability**

Habitat for Humanity of Collin County (HFHCC), is working hard to protect clients, the public, as well as staff and volunteers. To this extent, HFHCC is following the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and local health department guidelines to reduce the spread of COVID-19. I understand that these safety precautions maybe amended at any time and communicated to me verbally.

I understand and agree that while on the HFHCC premises or any premise that HFHCC is involved, I will participate in and comply with all of the following safety precautions.

- Cancel my appointment if I've experienced any symptoms that may be related to COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Take my temperature prior to leaving my home. If my temperature is above 99.6 degrees, I will cancel my appointment.
- Wear a face covering.
- Maintain six-foot distance from other people.
- Wash my hands using the 20 second method outlined by the CDC when entering the HFHCC Administrative Building, ReStores or any property that HFHCC is involved, after restroom breaks, and prior to leaving HFHCC.
- Refrain from touching my face or phone.

I am fully aware that there are a number of risks associated with me entering HFHCC property including contracting COVID-19 or other diseases which could result in a serious medical condition requiring medical treatment in a hospital or could possibly lead to death. I knowingly and freely assume all risks, both known and unknown, relating to my involvement volunteering on HFHCC properties or projects. I hereby forever release, waive, relinquish, and discharge HFHCC, along with their employees, volunteers, or other representatives from any and all claims, demands, liabilities, rights, damages, expenses, and causes of action of whatever kind or nature, and other losses of any kind, whether known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen as a result of my involvement with Habitat for Humanity of Collin County.

By signing this Waiver and Release of Liability form, I, the undersigned client volunteer or partner family, acknowledge that I have read, understood, and agree to be bound by all the terms, conditions, and information it contains. Ample opportunity has been offered to me to ask questions and seek clarification of anything unclear to me. Failure to comply with these written instructions or verbal instructions from staff or volunteers may result in your removal from the premises.
