Warrant Service

The officer spoke to the complainant about what occurred while other officers responded to Woodspring Suites to talk to the offender. Kearis Lowe, 26, of the 900 block of Frontage Road, Darien, was arrested and transported to the Darien Police Department and charged with two counts domestic battery and interfering with the reporting of domestic violence. Lowe was then transported to the DuPage County Jail.
