Heritage Singers is an optional choir for 2nd-8th grade students that meets every Monday from 12:45-1:30. Jubilate is an optional choir for 5th-8th grade students that meets every Wednesday from 12:45-1:30. 5th-8th grade students that choose to participate will be required to participate in both Heritage Singers and Jubilate. Heritage Singers/Jubilate provides a wonderful opportunity for 2nd-8th grade students to learn, enjoy, and perform a variety of types of music at several different special events throughout the year. These events include:

- Veteran's Day – Friday, November 9, 2018 at 10:00am (Heritage Singers only)
- Christmas Concert – Tuesday, December 18, 2018 at 7:00pm (Heritage Singers and Jubilate)
- Spring Concert – Tuesday, May 14, 2019 at 7:00pm (Heritage Singers and Jubilate)
- Adventureland – last week of school, during the day (Jubilate ONLY)
- 8th Grade Graduation – Wednesday, May 29, 2019 (Jubilate ONLY)
- Possible events to local hospitals and/or nursing care centers (Jubilate ONLY)

Students are **expected** to participate with a good attitude during rehearsals, show respect to the director and other students, and faithfully attend the performances. 2nd-4th grade students will be given an S/N/U grade on their report cards as their music grade is based upon concert participation AND behavior during practice. 5th-8th grade students will be given a letter grade on their report card as their music grade is based upon concert participation AND behavior during practice. We will give warnings and discipline slips (if necessary) to help redirect inappropriate behavior as spelled out in the *Parent/Student Handbook*. A performance may be excused due to illness or other emergency; however, please contact Miss Early (earlyn@hcs-nl.com) or Mrs. Sherman (shermana@hcs-nl.com) as soon as possible if your child will be absent.

Through participation in Heritage Singers the students will gain confidence, improve their musical skills, and have fun working together as a team.
