

3. Lead in Construction regulations.
 - a. On May 13, 2019, a Berkeley research firm issued its SRIA on revised regulations regarding lead in Construction.
 - b. The SRIA outlined that approximately 10% of construction workers in the state have an exposure to lead.
 - c. Bruce Wick pushed for further disclosure on what types of construction are more susceptible to lead exposures.
 - d. The information will allow CALPASC to advise its members as to what employees may be under the revised regulations.
 - e. Legislation is currently pending in the California legislature that would require the lead regulations to be in place by February 1, 2020.
