The survey was conducted Between March 24-30, 2021 and was sent to 171 Ontario PHU staff representing 34 PHU areas. There were 26 respondents representing Brant County, Halton, Hailburton-Kawartha-Pine Ridge, Hamilton, Hastings- Prince Edward County, Huron-Perth, Peel, Renfrew County, Southwestern, Sudbury, Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph, Windsor Essex and York PHU areas.

Said their rabies specimens were collected in a timely manner all of the time or most of the time.



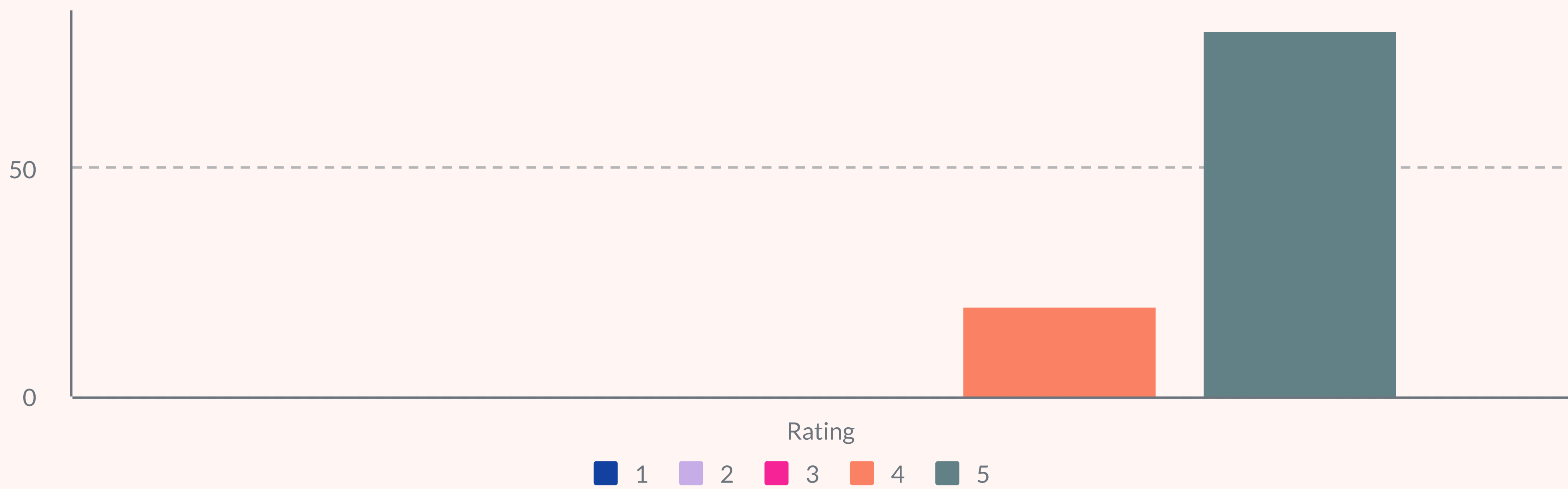
