Spring is here, and it has brought us some very nice weather. We have been very busy cleaning the course after the winter, and are part-way through aeration.

Currently, most of the tees and greens are finished, and fairway aeration will begin next week. As of the end of March, we have just removed the last of the covers on the tee boxes of holes 5 and 18, and they are in perfect shape. A few of the greens were less fortunate, and received some damage due to the heavy weight of the snow and ice on the covers during December and January. The repairs on those areas are almost complete, but will need some time to root down before allowing traffic on them.

The voles were quite active over the winter due to the extended snow cover, and consequently we are currently repairing an extensive amount of vole damage. Some bunker faces and areas surrounding a few greens and tees will require sodding due to the voles' winter appetite.

As has been the case for the last several years, we are removing broken and cracked areas of our cart paths, and will be pouring new cement during the first two weeks of April. For the bocce ball players, we have recently installed a new fence along the courts as a safety feature.

Our spring opening dates are:

- April 15 Holes 1-10 open (hole 6 will remain closed for a short time while the sod repair roots down)
- April 29 Course fully open




Sadly, the Montrêux community lost two longtime members in March, with the passing of John Barber and Michael Cho.
