While covid –19 put a stop to school attendance for months, the boys have eagerly returned! A girl is seen here also. Many more girls want schooling.





Improving Staff Remuneration: Good Help is Hard to Come by!

We have a significant ministry opportunity! As you may know, Healing Hands Ministries of Pakistan currently operates an orphanage for 40 boys, and has plans to expand the ministry to more area orphans, including girls!

The Need: Currently, 7 dedicated Christian people work every day to care for the boys, yet with no regular or normal financial compensation, no set salary, in a place where Christians have difficulty finding employment, are often persecuted and are left to starve in times of disasters and pandemics. The Orphanage does not house the workers or

their families. However, they are worthy of, and are in need of, a regular salary for their work!

The Plan: For Christian transparency and fiscal responsibility the funds given for the staff, as designated by regular financial contributors, will be separated from the funds given for the children and general operating costs. This is a change intended to better provide for the needs of both the children and the adults.

We would like to be able to tell you that "one staff person is fully funded" and so on, until all positions are funded, beginning at USD \$200/month per Staff person. Ideally, some would receive more per month - \$300 - \$450/USD.

Impact Opportunities

Seemingly small things make a big difference in our daily lives. Imagine 40 boys and seven men sharing two toilets, one sink and two showers! Oh the morning routine! They all want to get on with breakfast, worship, and learning activities.

Picture cooking outdoors, in the heat that averages 94-110° F with high humidity this time of year, what a tangible relief an exhaust fan would provide!

Pakistani Hope Children's Home urgently needs the following:

- 2 Security Guards, 12/hr shifts @ \$400/mo
- 2 toilets, 1 sink
- 4 showers
- 1 kitchen exhaust fan
- Over the counter Medical supplies
- 1 Air Conditioner for the bedroom
