

McNaughton Road East - Multi-Use Pathway

PLANNED WORK

The City of Vaughan is constructing a 3.0m wide asphalt multi-use pathway for shared use by pedestrians and cyclists on the south and west side of McNaughton Road East, between Keele Street and Major Mackenzie Drive (approximately 1.5 km in length).

This construction began Sept. 23, 2019 and is expected to be completed by **Dec. 16, 2019**.

PEDISTRIAN ACCESS

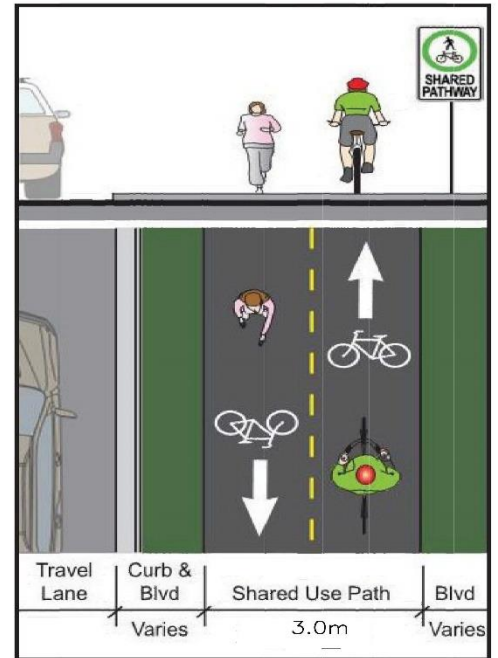
- Pedestrian access westerly from the GO Station to Keele Street will be available on the south side of McNaughton Road by Oct. 4.
- Pedestrian access easterly from the GO Station to Major Mackenzie Drive is available on the north side of McNaughton Road.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- McNaughton Road will remain open to vehicular traffic during construction and driveway accesses to businesses will be maintained.
- The eastbound curb lane on McNaughton Rd. will remain closed for vehicular access until Nov. 1.
