The Regional Municipality of York is investing in building a safe, efficient and reliable Regional transportation network for all users. Improvements to Keele Street from Steeles Avenue to 407 ETR are anticipated to begin in spring 2021 to accommodate growth and provide more travel options for all.

Construction start: spring 2021 | Anticipated completion: fall 2023

Improvements Include:

- Widening the roadway from four to six lanes, with on-street bicycle lanes
- Replacing the bridge over the CN railway tracks
- Extending and creating a continuous sidewalk to 407 ETR on both sides of Keele Street
- Upgrading all the intersections and street lighting to meet current Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA) requirements

The Keele Street improvements are being undertaken in phases to minimize disruption to travellers.

Phase 1:

- Traffic will shift to the west side of Keele Street and work will begin on the east side, including:
 - Road widening
 - Construction of the bridge over the CN railway tracks
 - Installation of the watermain from Steeles Avenue to 407 ETR


Impacts to traffic throughout the project:


- Lane reductions and short duration lane closures may be required for the delivery and removal of material and equipment between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Night work may be required for:
 - Work related to closing the ramps to and from 407 ETR between the hours of 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Water service connections to commercial and office buildings
 - Asphalt paving between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.


For everyone's safety, please reduce your speed through the construction area and contact us if you notice any safety issues in and around the construction site.
